

FAQs FOR CME/CE CREDITS

What credits are offered at the annual meeting?

8 credit types are offered:

- CME- Physicians
- Non-CME - all other except physician
- ACOG – American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists
- NPWH – Nurse Practitioners in Women’s Health
- PSY - American Psychological Association (mental health)
- NASW – National Association of Social Workers
- LPG – Legal Professional Group (legal credits)
- NSGC – National Society of Genetic Counselors

How can I know what credits are offered in each session?

There are 3 different ways to identify credit types:

- Meeting App - search by credit type.
- Online program - credit types by the session name.
- At the session location - a digital title sign outside the session displays the credits available.

Are all credit types offered for every session?

No. Credit types have selected sessions and courses approved to offer credits.

Do all credit types require sign-in at the session?

No. Sign-in is **only** required for **PSY, NASW, LPG, and NSGC** credit types. You can sign in and out via a link or QR code to OneTap.

Where can I find instructions for the OneTap process?

ASRMcongress.org has written instructions and tutorial links under the CME/CE tab.

Where is the sign-in link or QR code?

Attendees will have 3 ways to access it:

- ASRMcongress.org website under the CME/CE tab
- On the meeting app, under the CME/CE tab
- Scanning the table tents throughout the convention center

How do I claim my credits?

Credits can be claimed via the meeting app or evaluation link emailed from registration (Spargo).

The evaluation site will open after that day's sessions and remain open until **Friday, November 8, 2024, at 11:59 CST.**

Can I print my credit certificate?

Once all evaluations are completed, you can print credit certificates or email them to yourself.

Where do I get a certificate of attendance from?

Certificate of Attendance can be printed or emailed from the evaluation site.

Note: NSGC credits (genetic counselors) are required to pay \$40 to claim credits. It can be paid at registration or when claiming credits on the evaluation site.
